### OLD BUSINESS

1. Farmhouse floors: Per Sherill, City is obtaining quotes. She was present at Farmhouse when one contractor inspected the floors. Likely, everything on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the Farmhouse will need to be removed for approximately 3 weeks. - C. Mark has placed the wheel barrel in the shed. Kids from the bike trail have been using it which was okay but they refused to replace the wheel barrel by the mulch after use. Mark will get a combination lock for the wheel barrel and notify the garden volunteers of the combination.
