INFORMATION

The Assessor Division is responsible for valuing all real and personal property within Broomfield. These values are then certified to all taxing entities by the Assessor. The taxing entities use the values to determine their budgetary needs and calculate an appropriate mill levy to generate the necessary revenue for the upcoming year.

City and County tax is levied by the City Council. School taxes are levied by the school boards and special districts are levied by their board of directors.

If you should have any questions regarding the value of your property or the valuation process, the Assessor Division is always ready to assist and serve you.

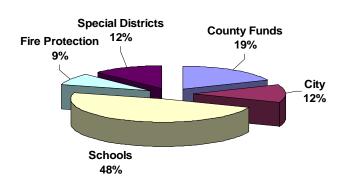

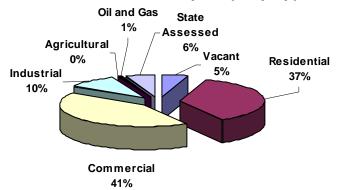
