Agenda Title: Proposed Resolution No. 2011-166 Regarding the Allocation of City & County Grant Funds for Arts, Culture and Science (ACS) Programs

Summary

- City Council approval is requested for the recommendations presented by the Broomfield Cultural Council for the allocation of Arts, Culture and Science (ACS) city grant funds, for use by recipient organizations in 2012.
- Arts, Culture and Science funding is budgeted at 10% of total SCFD Tier III funds received annually by Broomfield (less general operating support granted to auditorium operations per ordinance).
- The Cultural Council received 20 ACS grant applications for a total of \$26,301 in requests from organizations seeking funding for music, dance, drama, film, science and visual arts programs.
- There is \$12,400 in the budget for ACS grants. The Broomfield Cultural Council recommends allocating these funds to 19 nonprofit organizations presenting programs in Broomfield in 2012. These organizations are listed on page 3 of this memorandum.
- If approved by City Council, ACS grants will be distributed to recipient organizations in December. Reports from recipient organizations on use of city grant funds are due by March 1, 2013.
- Draft Resolution No. 2011-166 authorizes the allocation and distribution of Arts, Culture and Science city grant funds as recommended by the Broomfield Cultural Council.
- Members of the Cultural Council and Cultural Affairs staff will be present at the meeting to answer questions.

Prior Council Action

Beginning in 2005, the Broomfield Cultural Council submitted funding recommendations for qualifying cultural organizations to the City Council for review and approval using budgeted general funds. Since 2005, the City Council reviewed and approved annual funding recommendations as follows:

BACKGROUND

Arts, Culture and Science Grant Program Description

The Broomfield Cultural Council (BCC), at the request of the City Council, reviews Arts, Culture and Science (ACS) grant applications each fall. These applications focus on programs and projects that support *Creative Broomfield*, the cultural master plan, and benefit the Broomfield community. The BCC submits its funding recommendations to the Broomfield City Council in November for approval. Funds are used by grant recipients in the following year.

The application guidelines included several criteria to inform applicants:

- Programs or projects must be presented in the City and County of Broomfield to be considered for grant funding.
- Broomfield-resident organizations are given priority consideration.
- Innovative programs and projects that address an unmet science, cultural diversity or visual arts niche are encouraged.
- Requests for general operations funding, capital campaigns, grants to individuals, and trip and event sponsorships are not considered.
- Schools, libraries and nonprofits are encouraged to apply.

Funding Criteria

Cultural Council members evaluated each ACS grant application using a score sheet and the following criteria:

- A. The project demonstrates a clear understanding of mission and goals.
- B. The project will have a measurable impact on and/or outreach to Broomfield residents.
- C. The funds requested are reasonable and efficient for the scope of the project.
- D. The project financials are clear and concise.
- E. The project has a plan for diversification of funding.
- F. There is evidence that the project can be completed successfully.
- G. The project is creative, innovative and fills a special niche.
- H. The project furthers the Broomfield Cultural Master Plan.
- I. The project reaches out to diverse constituencies.
- J. The applicant has successfully completed projects.
- K. The applicant has evidence of self-assessment and uses it to advance program effectiveness.
- L. The applicant has a plan for collaborating with other organizations.

The council received grant requests in the amount of \$26,301. The council recommends funding 19 organizations in an amount equal to \$12,400. Priority was given to Broomfield based organizations that did not receive SCFD funding during this grant cycle. One grant was not funded because the request included equipment which had already been purchased. The proposed ACS Funding Plan is listed below.
