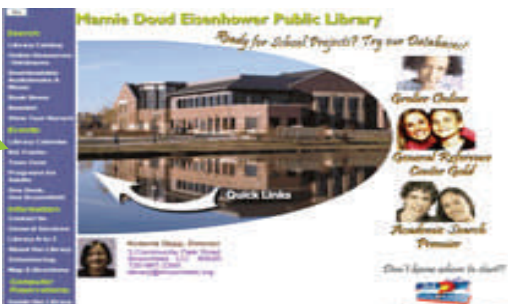


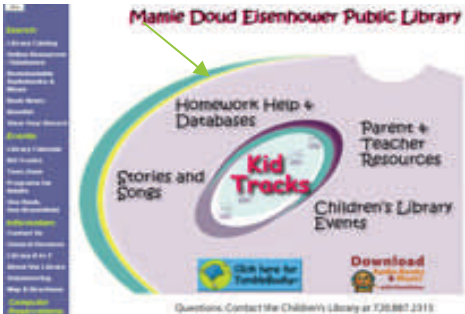

Library catalog – Find a book or other material in our library or another library in Colorado by using Proquest. If you find it in another library, we can try to get it sent here for you.

Research databases – Use our subscription databases to help find information. Our database list is separated out for adults or kids and teens.

Kid Tracks Homework Help – Link from our site to selected internet sites that are appropriate for kids.

Why do we buy research databases for you when the Internet is free?

- Databases narrow your search for useful, reliable, age-appropriate information.
- Databases are K-12 curriculum-relevant for students and teachers.
- Databases contain educationally approved encyclopedias, magazines, newspapers and books all easily searchable – this type of information is copyrighted and only available through subscription databases.
- Databases save time so you get to the information you want without sorting through material that is not useful or not for children.
- Various reading level designations allow for a wide variety of ability.
- Information is updated on a regular basis.
- Many sources are correlated to State & National Curriculum Standards.
- Teacher lesson plans and guidelines are available on many databases.
- Tutorials and other learning resources are available to help utilize the database more effectively.

World Almanac For Kids

A fundamental reference for students. It provides biographies, encyclopedia entries, facts, and statistics. Click on World Almanac for Kids at the bottom of the page in the Reference Box, (part of the SIRS Discoverer database).

EBSCO

Offers a broad range of full text and bibliographic databases including Kids Search for Elementary and Middle School and Searchasaurus for Elementary School. Also includes NovelList K-8 and NovelList K-8 Plus. (See Reading and Literature section for more information on these 2 databases.)
