

HOMEOWNER PERMIT APPLICANTS, PLEASE READ AND SIGN THE FOLLOWING:

Homeowner permits are available to property owners who wish to perform electrical work on any new construction, remodeling or repair on his/her own property or residence. Statutory provisions require that this property is NOT intended for immediate sale or resale, is not a rental property which is occupied or is to be occupied by tenant for lodging, either transient or permanent; and is not generally open to the public. I certify that all electrical work will be personally performed by me, and that the electrical work is not in conflict with the preceding description.

All wiring must be inspected prior to covering, i.e., insulation, drywall, etc., and again upon completion of the system, prior to occupancy and permanent power release. This normally will require a minimum of two visits by the inspector. In the event that corrections are required, a reinspection visit will be necessary and an additional fee may be charged.

Homeowner permits are not intended to circumvent the licensing and registration laws of the State Electrical Board of non-licensed individuals, firms, etc. All electrical work performed by the applicant must be done in accordance with the current edition of the National Electrical Code adopted by the State Electrical Board as the minimum standard.
