

120th Avenue Connection Project Update

Environmental Assessment to evaluate the 120th Avenue Connection across US 36

The City and County of Broomfield is preparing an environmental study for the future connection of 120th Avenue across US 36 to improve east-west travel. The proposed connection will provide a continuation of 120th Avenue across US 36 to SH 121 (Wadsworth Parkway) - a distance of approximately 1.5 miles. This important transportation project was previously identified as an initial phase of the proposed reconstruction of the Wadsworth Parkway/US 36 Interchange. Wadsworth Interchange improvements are now being evaluated by the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) as part of the ongoing US 36 Corridor Environmental Impact Statement. The 120th Avenue Connection is proceeding as a separate project.

120th Avenue Connection Open House Scheduled

Open House to provide opportunity for the public to comment on the Connection alignment and local access options

An Open House has been scheduled to update the public on the status of the project and to hear comments about the 120th Avenue Connection. The Open House is an opportunity for the public to talk directly with project engineers and planners and share your thoughts and concerns about the Connection. Comments received will be used to further develop the 120th Avenue Connection project.

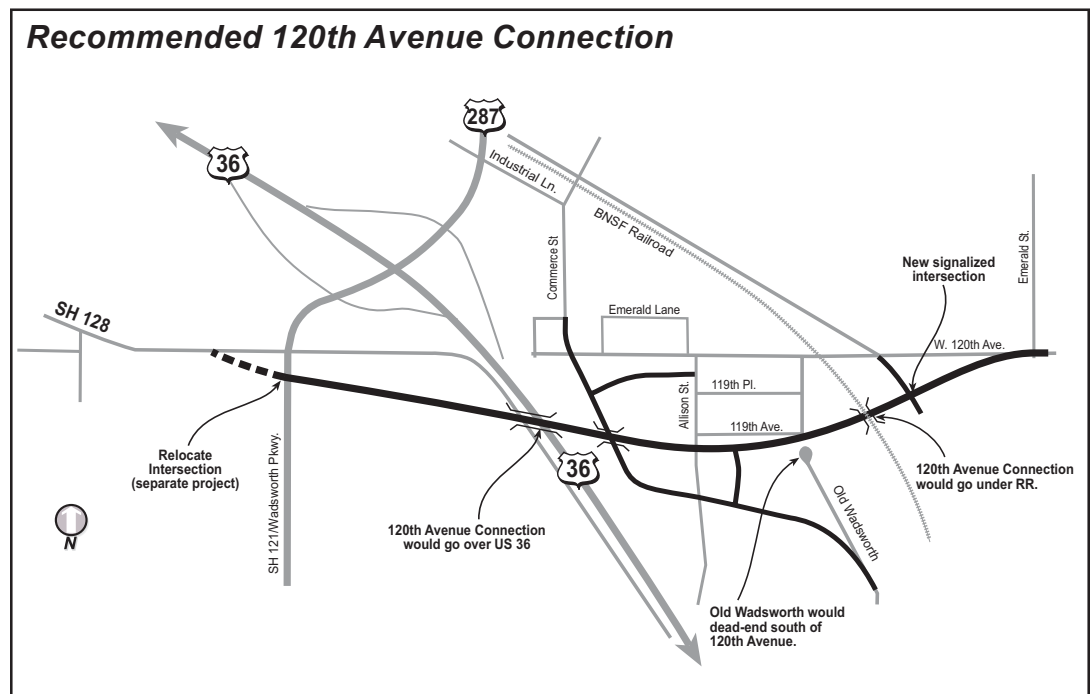

120th Avenue Environmental Assessment (EA)

Broomfield and its transportation consultants, Carter & Burgess, in coordination with the Regional Transportation District (RTD) and CDOT, are preparing the Environmental Assessment to evaluate potential social, economic, and environmental impacts of the project. It is anticipated that the EA will be completed in the fall of 2004.

The recommended alignment features a gentle horizontal curve beginning at 120th Avenue and passing under the BNSF Railroad tracks near 119th Avenue, crossing over US 36, and connecting with a relocated intersection of SH 128 and SH 121. The relocated intersection project is being prepared by CDOT as a Categorical Exclusion. Design and construction of the SH 128 and SH121 intersection will be completed prior to the construction of the 120th Avenue Connection.
