

APPROPRIATE DRESS/UNIFORMS

Generally, the appropriate dress for a work unit is left up to the individual. The way you dress may vary according to the department or division in which you work, and you are expected to use good common sense. Neatness and cleanliness are essential. For persons working in offices, dress should be consistent with the business atmosphere. Consult with your supervisor for further information on appropriate dress.

If your department furnishes uniforms, you will be required to wear them in conformance with your department's policy. The same applies to all safety clothing and safety items furnished by the department (safety shoes, safety glasses, hard hats, etc.) The City and County provides an allowance towards the purchase of approved steel-toed safety shoes and prescription safety glasses.

Check with your supervisor for further information on uniforms, personal protective equipment, and allowances provided by your department.

City and County-furnished uniforms should only be worn while you are on duty or going to and from work.
