To access Grolier Online, please go to:

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1. From the Passport or Kids home page, type in the Find It Fast! search box **J.K. Rowling (misspell the last name with an a)**. From the search results page, select the **NBK (The New Book of Knowledge)** result for J.K. Rowling. In the 3rd paragraph of the encyclopedia article, where does J.K. Rowling now reside?

2. From the Passport or Kids page, select **Advanced Search** located by the Find It Fast! box. Type in **J.K. Rowling** and the **Lexile range 750 to 1200**. What is the Lexile level of the **EA (Encyclopedia Americana)** article? _____ You can also find out the Lexile level from the encyclopedia article, by selecting Lexile in the upper thin orange banner. What does J.K. stand for? J _____ K _____. Scroll to the **bottom of the article** and name the **3 ways** that the **article is cited**.

3. From the Passport or Kids home page, type in **Harry Potter** in the Find It Fast! search box. From the search results page, select the **GME (Grolier Multimedia Encyclopedia)** result for Harry Potter. From the encyclopedia article, on the upper right hand side, select **web links**. What is the official web site for J.K. Rowling? _____ From the encyclopedia page, in the upper right hand side, select **periodicals**. What is the date of the first *Newsweek* article?
_____ Notice that all the periodical articles have abstracts and full text.
4. From the Passport or Kids home page, select **Atlas** by the Find It Fast! box. Starting out with the map of the World, click on the **word Europe**, followed by clicking on the **word United Kingdom** and then the **word Edinburgh**. On the left hand side of the Edinburgh map, select **City Center**. On the city center map, select the **blue photo icon** of the Edinburgh Castle. The castle dates back to _____.
5. From the Passport or Kids home page go to the **For Educator Section**, select lesson plans for **grades 3-5** and **language arts**. Now select the lesson plan **Letter Writing** and correlate the lesson plan to the **California Academic Content Standards**. What is the first standard listed? _____
6. From the **Passport home page**, in the middle of the screen in the News Now section, select **World Newspapers**. Scroll down to **Great Britain and North Ireland, United Kingdom of** and **click** on the **green GO button**. What is the name of the **Scotland newspaper (8th one listed)**?
_____ From the News Now section, select **From the Editor's Desk**. On the left hand side, select **Editor's Desk Archive** and then on the right hand column select the Pro/Con Debate, **Can Money Buy Happiness**. On the left hand side, select **lesson plan** from the **Teacher's Guide**. In the **vocabulary section**, what is the first vocabulary word? _____
7. From the Passport or Kids home page, on the left hand side of the screen, select the icon **La Nueva Enciclopedia Cumbre** and **entrar** (enter). On the left hand side of the Cumbre screen, select **Cosultar Categorías**, and then select **Geografía → Europa → Ciudades → Edimburgo**. In the Edimburgo encyclopedia article, **highlight** the first word **ciudad** and **select dictionaries** located by the Find It Fast! box. What does ciudad mean in English? _____.
