Parking is available at the Commons. Please do not park RVs and campers in the lots at the Commons. Additional parking is located at Legacy High School. Shuttle service to and from the Broomfield County Commons will be provided. Handicap parking available at the Commons west parking lot.

A lighting system, located as close to fireworks firing area as possible, will inform viewers of the status of the fireworks show. Weather permitting, green means the show is a "go." Yellow indicates it is in a holding pattern, and red indicates that due to weather concerns the firework show is cancelled. Rain Date is July 5.

Residents are reminded that weather conditions always play a role in this annual event. If fire and police officials determine that continuing the fireworks display impacts the safety of individuals and property in the area, the fireworks could be delayed or stopped. Strong winds in 2010 cancelled the fireworks show. Should that happen, measures such as announcements over the public address system in the stage area, and staff contact will be used to notify viewers of the status of the display. Rain Date for fireworks, cupcakes, icecream and the film premier is scheduled for July 5, 2011.
