

## **Mini Haha Triathlon Survey 2007**

### **How was your overall race experience?**

I had a great time throughout the race.

### **What did you enjoy the most?**

The 2007 race had 5 seconds added to each swimmer who started 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup>. I was the 5<sup>th</sup> swimmer and had 20 seconds added to my overall time.
2. The audio used in the award announcement was very hard to hear. If possible, use the Bay’s audio system.
3. Start the award ceremony at a specific time instead of noting an approximate time on the brochure.
