



Loan Closet History

Broomfield Senior Services has been helping caregivers cope with the added expense of acquiring adaptive equipment (wheelchairs, walkers, lightweight reachers /grabbers, canes, crutches, shower benches, and grab bars) by providing a recycling center called the “**Loan Closet**”.

Broomfield residents age 60 or over and caregivers of persons age 60 or over can borrow equipment from the Senior Center Loan Closet for their personal use at home for up to (2) months. After the equipment is returned, it is inspected for wear, sanitized and recycled to another person in need.

Loan Closet Rules

1. Loans are for 2 months maximum. Renewals of contracts will be accepted only if there is no waiting list for the requested equipment.
2. Customers will be asked to sign a contract and liability waiver on card.
3. A waiting list will be generated for persons waiting for equipment. First name on list will be called when equipment becomes available. If they are no longer in need of equipment, the next person will be called.
4. Equipment must be returned clean and in good working order.

Donations are accepted for the maintenance of our equipment and to keep it in good working order.

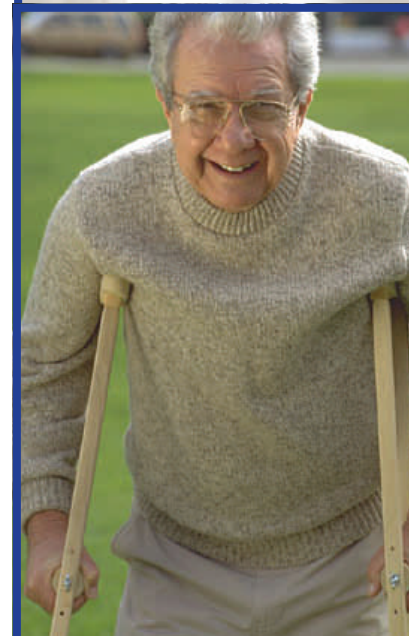
